## Frequently Asked Questions

**Q:** Should I collect a post-remediation comparison sample for a mold project if it is raining outside?

**A:** Contrary to popular belief, out-of-doors spore levels can be higher on a rainy day than on a sunny one. Some spore types are at peak levels in dry weather, but other whole groups of molds are found in abundance when there is high humidity, as during a rainy period.
